**Alison Brysk** has authored and edited numerous books on human rights, foreign policy and globalization. Professor Brysk's most recent book is *Global Good Samaritans: Human Rights as Foreign Policy* (OUP, 2009).

He has worked as Australian Human Rights Commissioner, Australian Law Reform Commissioner and Executive Director of the International Service for Human Rights. In 2007-08, he was Independent Chair of the UK Government's Northern Ireland Bill of Rights Forum.
